The applicant must have a baccalaureate degree and be currently enrolled as a graduate student in the third or fourth year of a mentored PhD or equivalent research degree program (e.g., DrPH, ScD) in the *biomedical*, *behavioral*, *or clinical sciences* at a domestic institution. The applicant must be at the dissertation research stage of training at the time of award, and must show evidence of high academic performance in the sciences and **commitment to a career as an independent cancer research scientist.**

If you are interested in submitting a preliminary proposal please send a statement of interest which provides a brief narrative about yourself (up to 200 words), including your current PhD or equivalent research degree program, and your mentor's name and contact information via e-mail to limited@unm.edu by noon, Friday, January 27, 2017. Based on the e-mail responses received, the Limited Competition Management Team may announce a call for preproposals. Please distribute this notice to departments and individuals whom you believe would be interested.

The deadline for full proposals to the agency is February 17, 2017.
