Dear UNM Researchers,

The purpose of the U.S. Dept. of Education's **Developing Hispanic-Serving Institutions Program** is to provide grants to assist Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) with expanding educational opportunities for, and improving the academic attainment of, Hispanic students. DHSI Program grants enable HSIs to expand and enhance the academic offerings, program quality, faculty quality, and institutional stability of colleges and universities that are educating the majority of Hispanic college students and help large numbers of Hispanic students and other low-income individuals complete postsecondary degrees. This opportunity has two Competitive Preference Priorities: 1) Meeting Student Social, Emotional, and Academic Needs and 2) Increasing Postsecondary Education Access, Affordability, Completion, and Post-Enrollment Success.

No award will exceed \$600,000 for a single 12-month budget period. Project Period: Up to 60 months. This program does not require cost sharing or matching unless the grantee uses a portion of its grant for establishing or improving an endowment fund. All applicants are encouraged to limit the Project Narrative portion of the application to no more than 55 pages. Visit

If we receive more than one SOI, we will request pre-proposals and will run a full limited competition.
