Subject: Limited Competition: Jennifer Riordan E2E Grant (JRE2E)

Date: May 31, 2019

This is a collaborative funding opportunity that brings together funders from across New Mexico to pool resources and make at least one high impact grant of \$50,000. This grant is a collaborative investment from funders in various sectors and they encourage organizations to demonstrate similar collaborative thinking when submitting applications. The JRE2E grant is focused on supporting middle school initiatives and advancing the future educational, personal and/or professional pathways of students in grades 6, 7 and 8. Applications must be serving students in Central New Mexico: Bernalillo, Sandoval, Valencia and/or Torrance counties.

The deadline to submit a full proposal to the sponsor is July 10, 2019.

This is a limited competition. Each institution is limited to one (1) proposal. Please submit your 3-page preproposal (plus budget and CV; all documents in a SINGLE PDF file, 11 point font) by NOON on June 17, 2019 to limited@unm.edu with the subject line indicating: JRE2E - your name. No late submissions will be considered.

The preproposal should address the major points that will be included in the proposal narrative:

1) Describe how your program fits into one (or more) of the following funding areas. A stronger application will show how your program fits into multiple funding areas:

- A. Parent/adult/mentor involvement
- B. Out-of-school time/extended learning programming
- C. Project-based learning
- D. Transitional programs
- E. Career readiness, teacher/professional development.
- F. Teacher/professional development

2) Describe measurable quantitative outputs and qualitative outcomes (who benefits and to what extent).

3) Describe the program, including the need for the program, the population who will benefit and the approximate number of people the program will serve and how your project achieves the goals of the grant opportunity.

4) Describe how you are sharing talent and resources with other organizations in our community.

5) Describe how you will facilitate educational opportunities for at-risk and underserved populations?

The 3-page narrative should be accompanied by a **draft budget overview** and a 2-page **PI CV**.
