The Office of the Vice President for Research is requesting statements of interest for the Dollar General Literacy Foundation Youth Literacy Grant funding opportunity.

Schools, public libraries, and nonprofit organizations who help students that are below grade level, or having trouble reading, are eligible to apply. Grant funding is provided to assist in the following areas:

- Implementing new or expanding existing literacy programs
- Purchasing new technology or equipment to support literacy initiatives
- Purchasing books, materials or software for literacy programs

The maximum amount of each grant is \$4,000. The deadline to apply is May 20, 2021.
