Dear UNM Researchers,

The Office of the Vice President for Research requests pre-proposals for the **NEH Summer Stipends** limited competition. This opportunity provides \$8,000 for two consecutive months in summer 2025 to support individuals pursuing advanced research that is of value to humanities scholars, general audiences, or both.

Limited Comp. Instructions: Please submit your 3-page pre-proposal, 1-page resume and 1 page bibliography via UNM's [InfoReady Review portal](#). No late submissions will be considered.

The pre-proposal should provide a comprehensive description of your project. Your narrative should be succinct, well organized, and free of technical terms and jargon so that peer reviewers can understand the proposed project. Label the sections of the pre-proposal: 1) *Significance and contribution*; 2) *Organization and methods*; 3) *Competencies, skills, and access*; 4) *Final product and dissemination*.

The pre-proposals will be evaluated on the following criteria: 1) intellectual significance of the proposed project, including its value to humanities scholars, general audiences, or both; 2) quality of the conception, definition, organization, and description of the project and the applicant's clarity of expression; 3) feasibility and appropriateness of the proposed plan of work; 4) quality or promise of quality of the applicant as an interpreter of the humanities; 5) likelihood that the applicant will complete the project (not necessarily during the period of performance), including, when relevant, the soundness of the dissemination and access plans.

On July 10th, 2024 (12:00-1:00 pm MDT), NEH staff will host a webinar for administrators and prospective applicants, introducing the program, describing the application/nomination process, and offering application-writing suggestions. To join the webinar, [register here](#).
