Dear UNM Researchers,

The Office of the Vice President for Research is requesting statements of interest for the **NSF Scholarships in STEM Network (S-STEM-Net) Program (NSF 23-536)**, which seeks to foster a community for S-STEM stakeholders and further develop the infrastructure needed to generate and disseminate new knowledge, successful practices and effective design principles arising from NSF S-STEM projects nationwide. To support collaboration within the S-STEM network, NSF will fund up to 5 S-STEM Research Hubs (S-STEM-Hub).

S-STEM Research Hubs are primarily formed to organize groups of researchers to conduct and disseminate rigorous qualitative and quantitative research on topics related to the S-STEM program and low-income student success. Each Research Hub should have a central focus that intersects a clear group of current and prospective S-STEM institutions.
