The Ralph E. Powe Junior Faculty Enhancement Awards provide seed money for research by junior faculty at Oak Ridge Associated Universities (ORAU) member institutions. These awards are intended to enrich the research and professional growth of young faculty and result in new funding opportunities. Full-time assistant professors within two years of their initial tenure track appointment (1/12/2013 through 1/11/2015) at the time of application at an ORAU member institution are eligible. The research project must be in one of the following five disciplines: Engineering and Applied Science, Life Sciences, Mathematics/Computer Sciences, Physical Sciences, and Policy, Management, or Education.

The award amount provided by ORAU is \$5,000. The applicant's institution is required to match the award with at least an additional \$5,000. This is a one-year grant (June 1 to May 31). Applications are to be submitted to ORAU by noon on Monday, January 12, 2015. Applications are reviewed in February/March, and awards are announced in late April.

This is a limited competition. Each institution is limited to two (2) proposals each year. Due to the minimal requirements for the final proposal, the Limited Competitions Management Team has abridged the requirements for internal review.

Please submit your 2-page pre-proposal (plus budget overview which includes the <u>costshare arrangements</u> and abbreviated CV; all documents in a SINGLE PDF file, 11 point font) by NOON on Monday, December 1, 2014 to <u>limited@unm.edu</u> with the subject line indicating: ORAU- your name. No late submissions will be considered. The pre-proposal should address the following:

- Research goals and objectives and relevant background
- Expected research outcomes and relevance
- Research design and methodology
- Competence of the applicant to perform the proposed research
- The available research facilities and resources
- A budget justification

The budget can include funds for faculty summer salary, graduate student salary, travel, equipment, or other assistance relevant to the faculty member's research. **ORAU does not allow overhead charges or indirect costs on the award from ORAU or the university match.**
