The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) is accepting applications for fiscal year 2019 for the Graduate Psychology Education (GPE) Program to train doctoral health psychology students, interns, and post-doctoral residents to provide integrated, interdisciplinary, behavioral health and Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) and other Substance Use Disorder prevention and treatment services in high need and high demand areas. The program also supports faculty development of health service psychology.

The GPE program fosters an integrated and interprofessional approach to addressing access to care with specialized training in the provision of OUD prevention and treatment services. Through these efforts, the GPE Program transforms clinical training environments and is aligned with HRSA's mission to improve health and achieve health equity through access to quality services, a skilled workforce, and innovative programs.

HRSA anticipates it will fund approximately 40 recipients. The ceiling amount for each proposal is \$450,000 in total costs (including both direct and indirect costs) per year. The performance period is three years: September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2022. Indirect costs will be budgeted and reimbursed at 8% percent of modified total direct costs rather than on the basis of a negotiated rate agreement.

This is a limited competition. An institution must select and submit an application for only one of either a:

- doctoral school or program of health service psychology; or
- doctoral internship in professional psychology; or
- post-doctoral residency program in practice psychology

If you are interested in submitting a proposal to either program type, please email a statement of interest with a tentative title, a brief project description (200 words), and names and departments of all senior personnel by <u>noon, Tuesday, April</u> <u>2, 2019</u> to <u>limited@unm.edu</u> with the subject line indicating: HRSA GPE - your name. Based on the e-mail responses received, the Limited Competitions Management Team may announce a call for preproposals.
