Subject: Limited Competition: The Moore Inventor Fellows

UNM Researchers,

The Moore Inventor Fellows program focuses on supporting scientist-inventors at a critical stage of research to capture opportunities that otherwise might be missed. The scope of this call is intentionally wide: proposed projects should align broadly with the areas of foundation interest: science, environmental conservation and patient care. The foundation aims to support inventions at an early stage that could lead to proof-of-concept work on an invention; or that can advance an existing prototype that tackles an important problem. They seek innovations with the promise of making a long-lasting impact by addressing underlying problems in the field, but a clear path toward commercialization is not a requirement.

<u>Candidates must be faculty, research scientists, postdocs, or other full-time staff at eligible institutions.</u> <u>Candidates must be no more than ten years past receiving the terminal advanced degree in their field (M.S., Ph.D. or M.D.)</u>. Each fellow is required to devote at least 25 percent of their time to their invention.

The funding amount is a total of \$675,000 (\$200,000 per year for three years and \$25,000 per year for indirect costs). <u>Cost share is required in the amount of \$150,000 (\$50,000 per year) and must be nonfederal funds.</u> <u>Unrecovered F&A and Imputed F&A cannot be used as part of the cost share contribution as per the sponsor</u>. Nominations must be received by the sponsor by 5:00 pm PT on November 15, 2019, with all application materials due by 5:00 pm PT on December 13, 2019. This is a limited competition. Each institution can submit two nominations for consideration. Please submit your 2-page pre-proposal addressing the review criteria below (plus budget overview, cost share budget and abbreviated CV; all documents in a SINGLE PDF file, 12-point font) <u>by NOON on</u> <u>Wednesday, October 23, 2019</u> to <u>limited@unm.edu</u> with the subject line indicating: MOORE - your name. No late submissions will be considered.

Your 2-page pre-proposal must include the following: The first paragraph should describe clearly and without jargon the invention, the problem it seeks to address, and its potential impact. This paragraph is to be followed by: 1) Description of the invention; 2) Importance in the area of science, environmental conservation, or patient care and experience; 3) Stage of invention; 4) Current funding; 5) Feasibility; 6) Approach for measuring progress during the three-year grant term; 7) Description of plan for meeting the cost share requirement.
