The Office of the Vice President for Research is requesting e-mails of interest for the NSF, Cybersecurity Innovation for Cyberinfrastructure (CICI) funding opportunity. The funding agency limits the number of proposals per institution to two.

CICI comprises two Program Areas: 1. Secure and Resilient Architecture and 2. Regional Cybersecurity Collaboration. Secure and Resilient Architecture awards will be supported at up to \$1,000,000 total per award for up to three years. Regional Cybersecurity Collaboration awards will be supported at up to \$500,000 total per award for up to two years.
