The Office of the Vice President for Research is requesting e-mails of interest for the NSF Partnerships for International Research and Education (PIRE) funding opportunity. A single organization may submit one preliminary proposal as the lead institution. Full proposals will be accepted by invitation only. There is no limit on the number of proposals in which an institution can participate as a partner.

PIRE projects must include collaboration with foreign research partners and international research experiences for students to promote a diverse internationally competitive science and engineering workforce. This PIRE competition will be open to all areas of science and engineering research which are supported by the NSF.
